SUMMARY OF JOB DESCRIPTION

The Commodity and Regulatory Affairs Department is responsible for monitoring state and federal legislative and regulatory issues that impact agriculture commodity production. Key responsibilities include conducting critical research and analysis of economic and public policy issues, such as proposals, regulations, and legislation, with an emphasis on livestock; addressing economic, regulatory, and legislative issues to ensure positive outcomes for Farm Bureau members; and overseeing programs and activities based on commodity-specific assignments related to livestock.
